- 1. If you currently hold and will continue to do so after your anticipated employment date, the right to work in the UK without sponsorship from Accenture.
- 2. If you are studying a degree level course in the UK and you hold a valid Student/Tier 4 General student visa which also gives you permission to work. Any work placement cannot exceed 50% of the total length of your course undertaken in the UK a letter will be required from your university to confirm this.
 - Please note that prior to your start date you will need to obtain written confirmation from your university regarding term dates you will only be able to participate in our Summer Vacation Scheme if the dates coincide with your university summer vacation.
