### FLASHLIGHT OPERATION

To turn on the flashlight, press the button marked with the light bulb symbol. To turn off the light, press the button again. To check the battery level of the installed batteries, hold down the button marked with the battery symbol. The red LED indicates the need to replace the battery.

### REPLACING THE BATTERY

To replace the batteries in the flashlight, unscrew the END CAP of the battery compartment by turning it counterclockwise. Remove the used cells from the compartment and replace them with a set of 3 x AA/LR6 batteries. When inserting the batteries, observe the polarity of the cells according to the diagram located inside the compartment. Place the END CAP back into position, ensuring that the battery contact spring is oriented towards the minus end of the battery. Tighten the END CAP until it stops. Verify the correct installation of the new cells by using the battery indicator. The light indicator should turn green.

### CAUTION!

Make sure you use only genuine parts designed for the flashlight. The use of spare parts from other manufacturers may affect the quality and parameters of the product. In accordance with EU's WEEE regulation, storage batteries must not be disposed of with normal household waste. Instead, they must be disposed at designated battery collection points. Check with your local garbage disposal company about the method and type of reprocessing or other instructions.
